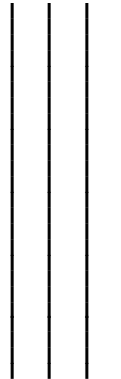

Open Heart Ministries (OHM) began in 2007 as an outreach ministry of the Greater Clarksburg Parish of United Methodist Churches. Since its beginning it has become an ecumenical ministry comprised of the United Methodist Churches in the immediate Clarksburg-Bridgeport area, Centerbranch Assembly of God, All Saints Roman Catholic Church, Christ Episcopal Church, Abundant Life Church, Connecting Point Church, Horizons Church, Jewel City Church, and St. Marks Lutheran Church.

This ministry reaches out to low-income individuals and families providing a variety of services that include assistance with utilities, rent, as well as other types of assistance. Ministry staff work with the Department of Health & Human Services, Criss Cross, and the Salvation Army. At times, OHM is able to assist when these agencies cannot. During 2010, OHM provided over \$49,000 in assistance to people in need in Harrison County. Using Space and resources provided by the United Methodist Church and volunteers, they have been able to operate at an overhead of less than 2%.

Pharmacy on main street and finishes in front of the entrance on Pike Street to Jackson Square (after 2.5 loops)

- Start in front of the Byard-Mercer Pharmacy on Main Street.
• The loop goes down Main Street to South 2nd Street for a left turn.
• Another left onto Pike Street to the right turn on North 4th Street.
• Straight into Glen Elk to Baltimore Avenue
• A left onto Baltimore - down two blocks.
• Left onto North 6th Street.
• Follow North 6th Street across the bridge past the post office and the Baptist Church to Main Street.
• Left on Main Street to the starting line (This is one loop)
• Do two loops and then the same loop back to Jackson Square and the finish.

Directions

From I-79

Take exit 119 towards Clarksburg (Route 50W). Travel on Route 50 West approximately 3 1/4 miles exiting onto Chestnut Street. Take a left hand turn at the second stop light (across from Go-Mart). The race begins on this street just past the Fire Department at Byard-Mercer Pharmacy.

From Route 50

Travel on Route 50 toward Clarksburg. Exit onto Chestnut Street. Take a left hand turn at the second stop light (across from Go-Mart). The race begins on this street just past the Fire Department at Byard-Mercer Pharmacy.
