Trophies to top 5 female and top 5 male finishers overall  
Medals to top finishers in age groups as follows:

Females: Top 3 in age groups 13-15, 16-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60 and over  
Males: Top 3 in age groups 13-15, 16-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60 and over

## 5K Race Walk

Medals to the top 3 female finishers and top 3 male finishers

## Fun Run/Walk

One mile loop of varied course, nearly level course  
Medals to all finishers.

Trophy for top finisher in age groups as follows:

Youngest, Oldest, and Best Overall Time  
\*\* Youngest trophy will be given to child who finishes by themselves. No children in strollers, carried, etc will count.

## Facilities for Water of Souths

Facilities and restrooms are provided for the event.  
Water stops at half mile mark for 5K and 1 mile for Fun Run/Walk race.

## Parking

Runners and walkers will need to Park at the Marion County Election Center.
