The outpouring of support during Scott's illness and at his passing opened his family's eyes to just how many lives he touched in his 26 short, but full, years. We have created the Scott A. Garett Memorial Foundation as a tribute to him and his valiant fight against lung cancer.

The money raised from the First Annual Flying Monkey 5K will be donated to the University of Pittsburgh Cancer Institute, and earmarked specifically for lung cancer research. Through this annual event and future others, the foundation will endeavor to increase awareness, raise funds, and allow Scott to continue impacting lives, albeit from afar.

About Scott

Scott A. Garett was a private math tutor and substitute teacher whose favorite pastime was competitive running. In September 2011, doctors discovered a tumor pressing on a nerve in his sacrum, which had been causing unbearable pain. The baffling diagnosis of stage IV mixed cell carcinoma lung cancer (small and squamous cell) did not affect Scott's trademark smile or fighting spirit. During his illness, as in healthier times, Scott made the most of each day—sharing laughter, expressing gratitude, and enjoying time with family and friends.
